CONSULAR SECTION OF THE ANGOLAN EMBASSY IN BELGIUM AND LUXEMBOURG

**MATRIMONIAL CAPACITY PROCEEDING**

NECESSARY DOCUMENTS:

**FOR THE ANGOLAN CITIZEN:**

- Birth certificate, **valid for 12 months**, duly recognised by the National Directorate of Registry and Notary Services and certified by the Ministry of Foreign Affairs.
  - If the marriage is to be held at a body of the Belgian Civil Registry, the birth certificate must also be certified by the Consulate of Belgium in Luanda.
- Passport.
- Consular Registration Certificate.
- Residence Certificate issued by the Municipal Administration of the area of residence, valid for 3 months and **translated into Portuguese by a sworn translator**.
- **For the groom**, at ages between 18 and 35 years, regularised military situation (submission of the military census certificate).

**FOR THE FOREIGN CITIZEN:**

- Birth certificate, valid for 3 months, **translated into Portuguese by a sworn translator**.
  - Birth Certificates from other countries, except Belgium, must be authenticated by the Consulate of Angola in the country of origin of the document and **translated into Portuguese by a sworn translator**.
- Residence Certificate issued by the Municipal Administration of the area of residence, valid for 3 months and **translated into Portuguese by a sworn translator**.

NOTE: The presence of the individuals contracting matrimony, or of a legal representative bearing a power of attorney or Public Instrument, is required at the time of delivery of the documents, for the signing of the respective records.
