DOCUMENTS REQUIRED

List of documents required to apply for an ordinary visa

1. Application form

- Available at the Consular Section in Brussels or at the website of the Embassy (www.angolaembassy.be).
- Please fill in **black ink** and in **block letters**.

2. Two identification photos

- Recent, in colour, without sunglasses.

3. Passport

- Valid (1 year).
- With three (3) blank pages.
- Photocopies of the main pages and, where appropriate, the visas obtained for Angola.

4. Residence certificate

- Issued by the Municipal Administration of the area of residence, valid for 3 months.
- **Translated into Portuguese by a sworn translator.**

5. Criminal Record Certificate

- Issued by the Municipal Administration of the area of residence, or by the Federal Public Service Justice.
 - **Translated into Portuguese by a sworn translator.**
- 6. Medical certificate**
- Issued by the country of origin and endorsed by the Ministry of Foreign Affairs.
- 7. Letter from the applicant**
- Addressed to the Angolan Diplomatic Mission, requesting a privileged visa.
 - Bearing a notarised signature and endorsed by the Ministry of Foreign Affairs.
- 8. Statement of commitment to comply with legislation in force in the Republic of Angola.**
- Bearing a notarised signature and endorsed by the Ministry of Foreign Affairs.
- 9. Valid **power of attorney** in favour of the person representing the investor in Angola, where applicable, bearing a notarised signature.**
- 10. Duly updated CRIP [Certificado de Registo de Investimento Privado] (Private Investment Registration Certificate) (issued by ANIP [Agência Nacional de Investimento Privado]).**
- Proof of the capital import licence of each of the investors for the requested investment, issued by the National Bank of Angola.
 - The constitution of the undertaking, bearing the name of all investors.
 - The investment project.

NOTE: This visa is granted for the purpose of implementation and execution of the private investment proposal (Private Investment Law)
