STUDY VISA

DOCUMENTS REQUIRED

List of documents required to apply for a short-term visa

1. Application form

- Available at the Consular Section in Brussels or at the website of the Embassy (www.angolaembassy.be).
- Please fill in **black ink** and in **block letters**.

2. Two identification photos

- Recent, in colour, without sunglasses.

3. Passport

- Valid (1 year)
- With three (3) blank pages
- Photocopies of the main pages.

4. Medical certificate from the country of residence

- Accompanied by the **respective sworn translation into Portuguese** ^(*).

5. Criminal Record Certificate

- Issued by the Municipal Administration of the area of residence, or by the Federal Public Service Justice.
- **Translated into Portuguese by a sworn translator.**

6. Letter from the applicant

- Addressed to the Angolan Diplomatic Mission, requesting a study visa.
- Bearing a notarised signature and endorsed by the Ministry of Foreign Affairs.

- 7. Statement of commitment to comply with legislation in force in the Republic of Angola.**
 - Bearing a notarised signature and endorsed by the Ministry of Foreign Affairs.

- 8. Evidence of sufficient means of subsistence.**

- 9. Proof of enrolment in an officially recognised educational institution or proof of attendance from such institution.**

- 10. Certificate issued by the institution awarding the academic degree or recognising the scientific interest of the work (where applicable).**

- 11. Internship programme or training contract (where applicable).**

- 12. For persons under legal age**
 - Travel authorisation from the parents or legal guardians, with notarised signatures.
 - Liability waiver from the parents or legal guardians, with notarised signatures.
 - Photocopy of the passport or identity card of the legal guardians.

IMPORTANT NOTES

All documents must be presented upon request and all incomplete applications shall be rejected.

Any misrepresentations and/or document forgeries shall be punishable under legislation in force in the Republic of Angola.
