DOCUMENTS REQUIRED

List of documents required to apply for an ordinary visa

1. Application form

- Available at the Consular Section in Brussels or at the website of the Embassy (www.angolaembassy.be).
- Please fill in **black ink** and in **block letters**.

2. Two identification photos

- Recent, in colour, without sunglasses.

3. Passport

- Valid (1 year).
- With three (3) blank pages.
- Photocopies of the main pages.

4. Residence certificate

- Issued by the Municipal Administration of the area of residence, valid for 3 months.
- **Translated into Portuguese by a sworn translator.**

5. Criminal Record Certificate

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- Issued by the Municipal Administration of the area of residence, or by the Federal Public Service Justice.
 - **Translated into Portuguese by a sworn translator.**
- 6. Medical certificate**
- Issued by the country of origin and endorsed by the Ministry of Foreign Affairs.
- 7. Letter from the applicant**
- Addressed to the Angolan Diplomatic Mission, requesting a privileged visa.
 - Bearing a notarised signature and endorsed by the Ministry of Foreign Affairs.
- 8. Statement of commitment to comply with legislation in force in the Republic of Angola.**
- Bearing a notarised signature and endorsed by the Ministry of Foreign Affairs.
- 9. Proof of sponsorship**
- Signed by the person who will be hosting, or proof of ownership or lease of residence, recognised by an Angolan Notary Public and certified by the Angolan Ministry of Foreign Affairs.
- 10. Proof of family ties with an Angolan citizen or with a foreign national legally residing in the country.**
- 11. Evidence of sufficient means of subsistence.**
- 12. Original proof of accommodation**
- Proof of the type of accommodation
- 13. For persons under legal age**
- Liability waiver from the parents or legal guardians, with notarised signatures.



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- Original and photocopy of the passport and original and photocopy of the birth certificate of the minor.

NOTE: This visa is granted for humanitarian and religious reasons, scientific research work, family accompanying holders of Study, Medical Treatment, Privileged or Work Visas, for spouses of national citizens or relatives of holders of valid residence permits.

This visa does not allow the exercise of gainful employment.

IMPORTANT NOTES

All documents must be submitted upon request and all incomplete applications shall be rejected.

Any misrepresentation and/or document forgery shall be punishable by law.

(*) Translations must be done by a duly sworn translator. For ordinary visas, the signature and stamp shall be necessary and sufficient.
